Red Wine - Pinot noir

Village: Santenay

Surface Area: 38a 66ca

Average Age of Vines: 35 years

Exposure/Soil: The presence of different faults and types of limestone soils justifies the presence of Pinot Noir, leading to an increasingly important production of red wines in certain sectors. The Bourgogne Pinot Noir comes from plots located in the village of Santenay (Vaux Dessous).

Vinification/Ageing: 100% destemming, cold pre-fermentation maceration, ageing in 500-liter barrels (no new barrels).

Production: 2,900 bottles.
