

DOMAINE GROS-TOLLOT LA CIAUDE – MINERVOIS CAZELLES

Anne Gros and Jean-Paul Tollot, both fifth-generation winemakers in their respective domains in Vosne-Romanée and Chorey-les-Beaune in Burgundy, joined their expertise in 2008 to serve the Terroirs de Cazelles in Haut Languedoc Regional Nature Park. Their domain is comprised of 16 hectares of vineyards split into 6 Terroirs, 5 of which are already known as L'O de La Vie (Rec Del Vié), Les Combettes, Les Fontanilles, La Ciaude, and Les Carrétals. LA 50/50, LA CinsO and LA Grenache 8 complete the range with their own personality.

Thanks to the impulsion of ten winegrowers, the argilo-calcareous and South-exposed plateau is now classified as "Minervois Cazelles".
